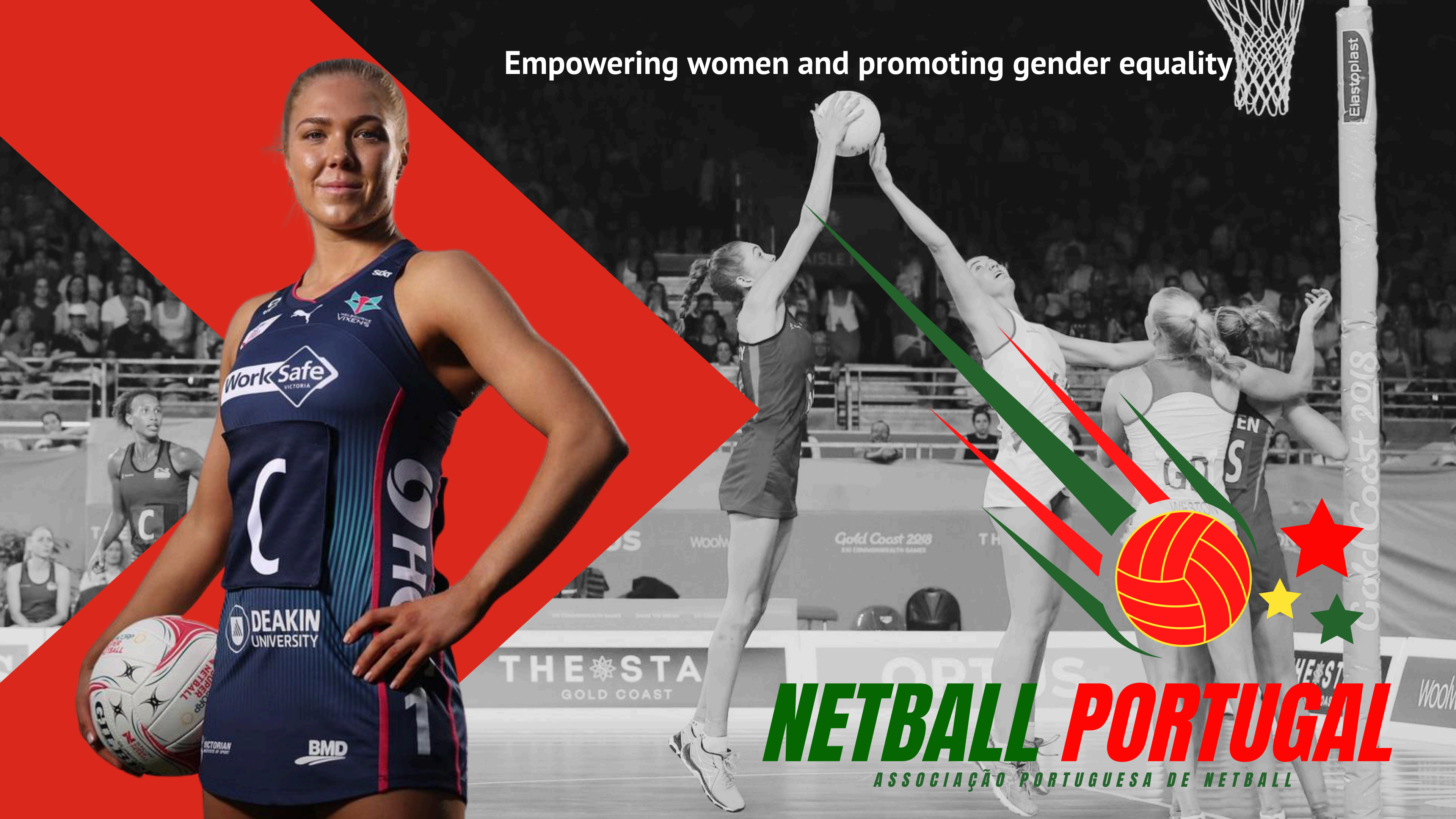

KEY FACTS AND FIGURES



- **Participation** - Over 20 million people play netball across 80+ countries, with strong followings in Australia, New Zealand, the UK, South Africa and Jamaica
- **Major Tournaments** - Netball World Cup (NWC): held every 4 years, the top competition for national teams. Commonwealth Games: netball featured since 1998. Fast 5 Netball Series: A fast-paced, shorter version of the sport held annually.
- **Viewership** - The 2019 Netball World Cup attracted over 100,000 attendees and was viewed by over 20 million people worldwide.
- **Sponsors** - Key sponsors include Vitality (UK), Suncorp (Australia), Nike and Gilbert Netball. Broadcasters like Sky Sports and major brands help boost netball's visibility.
- **Growth**: - the sport is expanding rapidly in Europe, Asia and Africa, with aspirations to become an Olympic sport, further increasing its global impact.

1ST & 2ND NOV 2025 - ADULT AND YOUTH NETBALL, LISBON

MAY 2025 - WALKING NETBALL, VILAMOURA

We are organising an exciting walking netball tournament in the beautiful coastal town of Vilamoura, with over 25 clubs from Portugal and around the world looking to participate.

JUNE 2025 - FUTURE STARS NETBALL FEST, ALGARVE

This planned festival will provide a great opportunity for young players to compete internationally while enjoying the coastal scenery and social events.

PRESIDENT

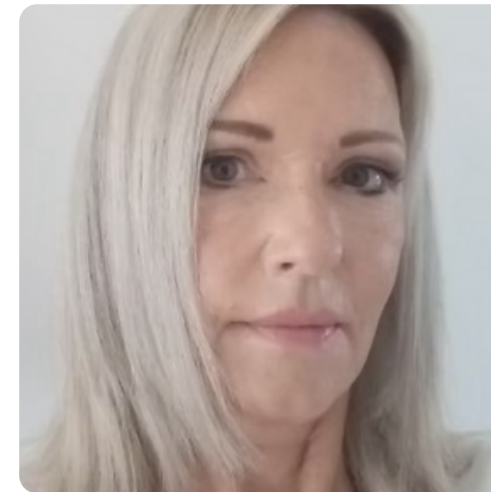

FUNDING & FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Total for Training Kits: €7,000

Kits/Uniforms: €100 per kit for 50 players = €5,000, Training Equipment, €2,000

Total for Coaching Development: €7,000

Coaching Development Courses: Fees for training sessions & certifications, €4,000. Workshops, clinics sessions expert coaches, €3,000

Total for Miscellaneous Expenses: €16,000

National Marketing and Promotion: Creating awareness and attracting players = €12,000, Insurance: Necessary coverage for players and events = €2,000, Administrative Costs: Setting up the federation, including registration and legal fees = €2,000

Total for Tournaments: €18,000:

Entry fees for competitions, estimated €600 for tournaments for 5 events = €3,000, Logistics (venue hire, officials): Costs for organising events = €14,000. Awards and Prizes: Medals and trophies for participants = €1,000

Total for Transport Costs: €8,000

Transport for Teams/Coaches: Buses for local travel to tournaments (estimate €600 per trip for 10 trips) = €8,000

TOTAL ESTIMATED FUNDING REQUIREMENT:

€56,000
